

SIGHTS AND STOPS

HIGHLIGHTS OF STOCKHOLM - 1 May - 3 October

- STRÖMGATAN / OPERAN** Departure point for Highlights of Stockholm (blue).
- REGERINGSGATAN / GALLERIAN** Central shopping area. Shops include Ahlens City department store, with a wide assortment of Swedish and international brands, and the NK department store, with a tourist information office providing tips and assistance.
- HÄMNGATAN** One of the best shopping districts in town.
- STRANDVÄGEN / NYBROKAJEN** Shopping district with exclusive restaurants. Departure point for excursions and dining cruises in the archipelago. *Change to Hop On - Hop Off boat!*
- VASA MUSEUM / NORDISKA MUSEET** Vasa Museum with the world's only surviving 17th-century ship. Other museums in the area; Nordiska museet and Junibacken. *Change to Hop On - Hop Off boat!*
- GRÖNA LUND / ABBA** Stockholm's amusement park for grown-ups and kids. It's also home to the Liljevalchs (art and design) and the ABBA Museum, which is set to open in May 2013. *Change to Hop On - Hop Off boat!*
- SKANSEN** A miniature Sweden with historical quarters and Nordic animals, in the Aquarium you can pat a snake. Christmas markets during December.
- HISTORISKA MUSEET / DJURGÅRDSBRON** Djurgården's Visitor's Centre is located here, providing info on all of the museums, attractions and activities on Djurgården. A short walk to The Swedish History Museum, the museum of Vikings and the beautiful Gold Room.
- FRIHAMNEN** One of Stockholm's ports. Arrival and departure point to cruise ships.
- KARLAPLAN** Great architecture in the wealthier areas of the city. Nearby is Historiska Museet / The National Historical Museum.
- STUREPLAN** Exclusive shopping, restaurants and nightlife!
- HÖTORGET** Stockholm's central fruit and vegetable market. Stockholm Concert Hall, where the Nobel Prize ceremony takes place, is also located here. Excellent shopping, restaurant and cinema facilities.
- NORRA BANTORGET / CLARION SIGN** Many hotels and restaurants. A number of large pavement cafés attract a lot of summertime visitors.
- ICE BAR / CASINO COSMOPOL** Experience Stockholm's coolest bar! The temperature is -5°C all year round. Close to Stockholm's international casino - Casino Cosmopol.
- CENTRAL STATION** Trains connecting Stockholm with Arlanda Airport and other cities. Close to Drottninggatan shopping district.
- CITY HALL** Home of the Nobel Prize dinner.
- KORNHAMNSTORG** Provides access to the restaurants, cafés and shopping streets in the western areas of Gamla Stan.
- SLUSSEN** The link between the Old town and the island Södermalm and between lake Mälaren and the Baltic Sea.
- STADSGÅRDEN (CRUISE BERTH)** One of Stockholm's ports. Arrival and departure point to cruise ships.
- SKEPPSBRON** Old town meets Södermalm. Good stop for a quick walk to Fotografiska museet and the shopping of Södermalm.
- THE ROYAL PALACE, STOCKHOLM CATHEDRAL (STORKYRKAN) AND THE OLD TOWN** The original heart of Stockholm - one of the largest and best preserved medieval city centers in Europe. This is where Stockholm was founded in 1252. *Change to Hop On - Hop Off boat!*

CITY & ROYAL HAGA - 1 July - 4 August

- GUSTAV ADOLFS TORG AND THE ROYAL OPERA** Departure point for the Haga Palace line (green)
- KULTURHUSET** Visit Stockholm's hot spot for contemporary cultural events. Photo exhibitions, stories for kids, concerts, literary discussions etc. Close to Ahlens City department store with Swedish and international fashion.
- HARD ROCK CAFE** Visit the world known Hard Rock Cafe before you explore Vasastan. The public Library with the rotunda is also worth a visit.
- HAGA SÖDRA - MEETING POINT FOR THE HAGA BOAT TOUR** A large and popular nature area with many interesting buildings such as the Chinese Pavilion, Gustav III's Pavilion, the copper tents and of course the Haga Palace; residence of The Crown Princess Victoria and Mr Daniel Westling.
- KAROLINSKA INSTITUTET** Medical university
- VASAPARKEN/S:T ERIKSPLAN** Inner city park with a nice café during the summer. The famous author Astrid Lindgren lived close by during a long period of her life.
- CLARION HOTEL SIGN** Modern designed hotel at walking distance from Kungsholmen. Visit the Selma CitySpa with an outdoor pool on the roof.
- ICE BAR / CASINO COSMOPOL** Experience Stockholm's coolest bar! The temperature is -5°C all year round. Close to Stockholm's international casino - Casino Cosmopol.

HOP ON - HOP OFF BOAT - 4 May - 8 September

- A NYBROPLAN** Shopping district with exclusive restaurants. Departure point for excursions and dining cruises in the archipelago.
- B VASA MUSEET** with the world's only surviving 17th-century ship. Other museums in the area; Nordiska museet and Junibacken.
- C SKEPPSOLMEN** The island is home to Moderna Museet (modern art), the Museum of Far Eastern Antiquities and the Swedish Museum of Architecture.
- D TIVOLI GRÖNA LUND / DJURGÅRDEN** The area houses Gröna Lund (amusement park with the world's biggest Zac-Spin coaster), Skansen (Nordic animals and historical buildings), Aquaria Water Museum, Liljevalchs (art and design), the Museum of Spirits (Absolut Art Collection).
- E CRUISE BERTH / VIKING LINE** Port for cruise ships.
- F FOTOGRAFISKA** The museum presents exhibitions by famous photographers. A museum shop for photography lovers.
- G OLD TOWN** The original heart of Stockholm. Plenty of restaurants, pubs, souvenir shops and boutiques. The closest stop to the hip district SoFo at Södermalm.
- H ROYAL PALACE** The Swedish Royal family's official residence, with the Gustav III's Museum of Antiquities, the Royal Apartments, the Treasury. Nearby is Storkyrkan, Stockholm Cathedral St. Nicolai, which housed the royal wedding of H.M King Carl XVI Gustaf and H.M Queen Silvia in 1976 and H.R.H Crown Princess Victoria and Prince Daniel Westling in June 2010.
